The Max City Council met Monday, September 11, 2017, at 7pm. Mayor Joel Hauf and council members Jon Hauf, and Heather Bostow were present Randy Swanson and Nathan Schneider were absent. Visitors in attendance: Nathan Amick of Ackerman Estvold; Richard Gullickson; Raymond Iverson, Jody Gullickson

Meeting called to order.

Jon Hauf moved to approve and dispense with reading minutes from the previous meeting; Bostow second, all voting aye, MC.

A motion was made by Jon Hauf, 2nd by Bostow to approve the financial statements, approval of the bills, the water delinquency report and the court report. Motion carried unanimously.

Council Concerns: Wenger asked for some time off. Also discussed was Wenger needs to make sure gate valves are exercised, sewers and hydrants get flushed.
