

The Max City Council met Monday, June 6, 2016, at 7pm. Mayor Joel Hauf and Council members Chad Talbott, Dick Gray, and Jon Hauf were present and Randy Swanson was absent. Meeting called to order.

Jon Hauf moved to approve and dispense with reading minutes from previous meetings; Talbott second, all voting aye, MC.

Amick gave council map regarding patching of pavement and discussion about those proposed changes was held.

Polsfut spoke to council regarding special assessment from 2014. Council consensus to table for the next meeting so they can have full information and full council. Polsfut also discussed his concerns regarding the parking ordinance and truck routes within the city.

Huettl of P&Z gave the council 1 permit application. They recommend building permit 2016-7 for LaVonne Fannik to be approved for shingling. Talbott motioned to approve recommendations as presented, Jon Hauf second, all aye, MC. It was also noted lawn sheds that are not permanently attached and can be moved do not add value and therefore will not need a permit. Council discussed the truck parking ordinance and heard from visitors present. It was also asked that the council consider adding to the ordinance language that would make it unlawful to park and block a mailbox. A council committee is actively working on reviewing the ordinance.

Songstad has started employment for the temporary position. Crack sealing will be completed this week. Complaint was received regarding park not being mowed, council talked about the landfill and the burning variance, It was also asked if Travis Sampson could park in the shop during the reunion for cleanup.

Council reviewed court report and delinquent water accounts. It was mentioned that assessments will be made to the owners properties can be done for renters with unpaid bills.

Open Discussion: Huettl some items with the council for the all school reunion. Huettl also noted St. Matthews will be fixing their sidewalk and would like the curb stop to be looked at.
