Meeting called to order.

Mayor Zabka announced:

The table was opened for nomination for Council Member to serve a one-year term on the Library Board. Swanson motioned to appoint Adams, Fritel second. Vote all aye. m/c/a.

Discussion held on committee assignments. Swanson motioned to appoint Adams for Streets, Westman 2nd Vote all aye. m/c/a. Adams motioned to appoint Swanson for Law Enforcement, Fritel second. Vote all aye. m/c/a. Swanson motioned to appoint Westman to Water, Adams second. Vote all aye. m/c/a. Adams motioned to appoint Fritel to Public Relations, Swanson second. Vote all aye. m/c/a.

Swanson motioned to continue appointment of Anita Porter as City Auditor, Fritel second. Vote all aye. m/c/a. Oath was taken and notarized by Judge Krebsbach, and will be filed at the McLean County Auditor's Office, as official record.

Ashely Beall will remain the city attorney, and Ackerman Estvold as Engineering Firm for the City of Max.
