

ORDINANCE NO. 106-B

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF CERTAIN ANIMALS IN CITY LIMITS.

Section 1: Keeping of certain animals prohibited; exception; penalty.

- It shall be unlawful to keep any live sheep, pigs, cattle, chickens or other poultry, goats, horses, venomous or constrictor snakes in the City of Max.
- This section shall not apply to special occasions such as Rodeo Days, Wagon Train, Parades or Petting Zoos.
- Any person who shall violate the provisions of this section for which a specific penalty is not otherwise provided shall be guilty of an infraction for which the minimum penalty is a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and for which the maximum penalty is a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00). The owner of any animal impounded pursuant to the provisions of this article shall pay all costs and charges assessed for such impoundment before such animal shall be released to the owner.


Section 2: Cleaning of animal waste prohibited; penalty.

- It shall be prohibited to clean raw animal waste or fecal matter from any transport vehicle within City limits.
- Any person who shall violate the provisions of this section for which a specific penalty is not otherwise provided shall be guilty of an infraction for which the minimum penalty is a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and for which the maximum penalty is a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
