

ORDINANCE NO. 109 B

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING FILL ON EXCAVATIONS IN THE CITY STREETS AND  
REQUIRING STATIONARY RODS INSTALLED WITH EACH CURB STOP AND  
PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF:

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Max, North Dakota as follows:

SECTION 1: It is required that any person making an excavation or digging in the streets of the City of Max, North Dakota shall fill any excavation with sand and gravel so to prohibit any settling of the street. If settling occurs person that did digging is to make needed repairs at their expense.

SECTION 2: It is required that any person installing a curb stop connecting to the water system for the City of Max, shall install stationary rods with each curb stop.

SECTION 3: Penalty. Any violation of this ordinance shall be subject to punishment by a fine of not more than \$500.00, in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect and will be in full force effective upon the date of passage.
